The Summer school for curatorial studies in Venice is an English-taught, intensive program on the history of contemporary visual arts and practices of exhibition-making, taking place during the International Art Biennale of Venice. Through interdisciplinary lectures, the program provides practical training and experience within museums and exhibition settings, museum studies and temporary exhibition.

A major part of the program is devoted to activities such as artist studio visits, tours of exhibition spaces, networking events, workshops and culminates with the set up of an exhibition or an art event at Aplus A Gallery. Its international faculty includes curators and museum professionals, artists and critics.

The fee of the Summer school is 4500,00 euro and it does not include accommodation and living expenses and extra travelling. The living costs and the accommodation a month in Venice could be estimated around 1000/1200,00 euro.

After completing the course the candidates receives a certificate of attendance and the student is achieving all the skills for working in curatorial field, how to organize and conceive an exhibition. Best regards
